- Waterfront Parks Application to BPRW (due mid October '21) Gene, Bill, Don Swain
- Presentation/Update on the 2022 International Show (above) Gene Porter and Bill Truex. Bill introduced Chris Jarvis from Northfield Savings Bank as our 2022 show sponsor. Bill handed off to Gene for the status report from the ACBS and ADK chapters. Gene discussed his visit with the ADK chapter and ACBS International show and his presentation to get people excited to come to our 2022 show. Gene walked us through the event line up for our week of September 5th- 11, 2022 and discussed time frame and locations of pre-events. Gene found much enthusiasm from attendee's at Couer D'Alene about our show and feels we will have many people attend our event.
- Gene handed off to Bill Truex: Bill Discussed the Indemnification clause and our lawyer working on issues with Shelburne Museum and Basin Harbor Club. He has been counseled not to sign any documents until these establishments change the language in their contracts. Bill reviewed Dan leaving ACBS as director and a new person coming and how that impacts our contracts. Bill discussed insurance within the contracts, we as a chapter do not have insurance, we get it from ACBS. Bill discussed Chapter Hosted Events as Pre-Events and thanks to our sponsors we can carry the cost of these. He explained registration fee's and advantages of going to Essex, NY for a Chapter Hosted event. Reviewed registration at ACBS hotel and Dan's negotiations with Echo for the Wednesday night event. Chapter dinner on Spirit of Ethan Allen with Art Cohn, Boating through history and the great warpath as our focus was reviewed. Auction and awards dinner explained. Debriefing of our local show at Burlington Harbor Marina and planning points going forward for the 2022 show, Issue with 100 slips at Burlington Harbor Marina not being enough and in prospective negotiations with the city to utilize the waterfront docks and also the green space between the two marinas. Bill discussed the sailing component of our planned show and Fritz's display plans along with the Sailing Center and land that will be needed, including possible field of dreams, vendors, port-

o-lets, tents and the green space. Asking for Moran Plant "Frame" to organize space along with water department space. Discussed Alex Caruthers and Grace Potter and dates of our show vs their concert, these dates are up to the city so we are not sure we are getting this property or not. Discussed trying to get a shuttle for our waterfront area and asked for any-one with knowledge of utilizing hospital vans let him know. Bill handed off to Gene: We have many balls in the air, we will know more at the end of November as to what we will get from the city. At that point we will need to step up to each aspect of the plan. Bill asked how can you fit into this emerging enterprise? Sue Haigh: sign up sheet in the front of the room with options for volunteering, sign up now or let her know, get involved.

- Susie Becker Volunteer Solicitation, Susie asked for people to step up and help out with the many positions we will need to fill, people who can direct other people, people with knowledge of Burlington. She will start sending emails mid winter with more details.

Holly discussed the two part auction process, silent auction at the Hilton Hotel and a dinner auction requiring registration. Please let her know if you have anything to donate to either auction.
