An update on Membership Directories by Gene Porter


One of the goals of our LCACBS Chapter is to encourage a friendly community of like-minded boating aficionados who are eager to share their experiences and knowledge. One of the key tools for such sharing has historically been the printed chapter directory which provides contact information and boat information.

This has traditionally meant maintaining and distributing an updated printed directory, an endeavor that takes considerable volunteer time as well as printing and mailing costs. In recent years ACBS Headquarters has modernized its online systems making it easier for members to access the Member Directory online. Following this example, the Board of Directors has decided to stop the annual printing and distribution of a chapter directory, turning instead to an online version.

The online directory is easy to access. Just go to acbs.org and click on "Member Log In". Once logged in, click directory. To find information for LCACBS members, click on the Chapter header and choose Lake Champlain. You can also find any ACBS member by entering a members first or last name or even a boat name.

The Board hopes that this procedural change will help strengthen our community while reducing errors. Please help us by keeping your contact information up to date. If you would prefer a printed Directory, please let Holly know.




